



TRAVEL AND PARKING AT ST BARTS

Many SWGP Meetings are held at [St Barts Church](#) in Bath, including our Thursday [Ministry Training Course](#).

Train

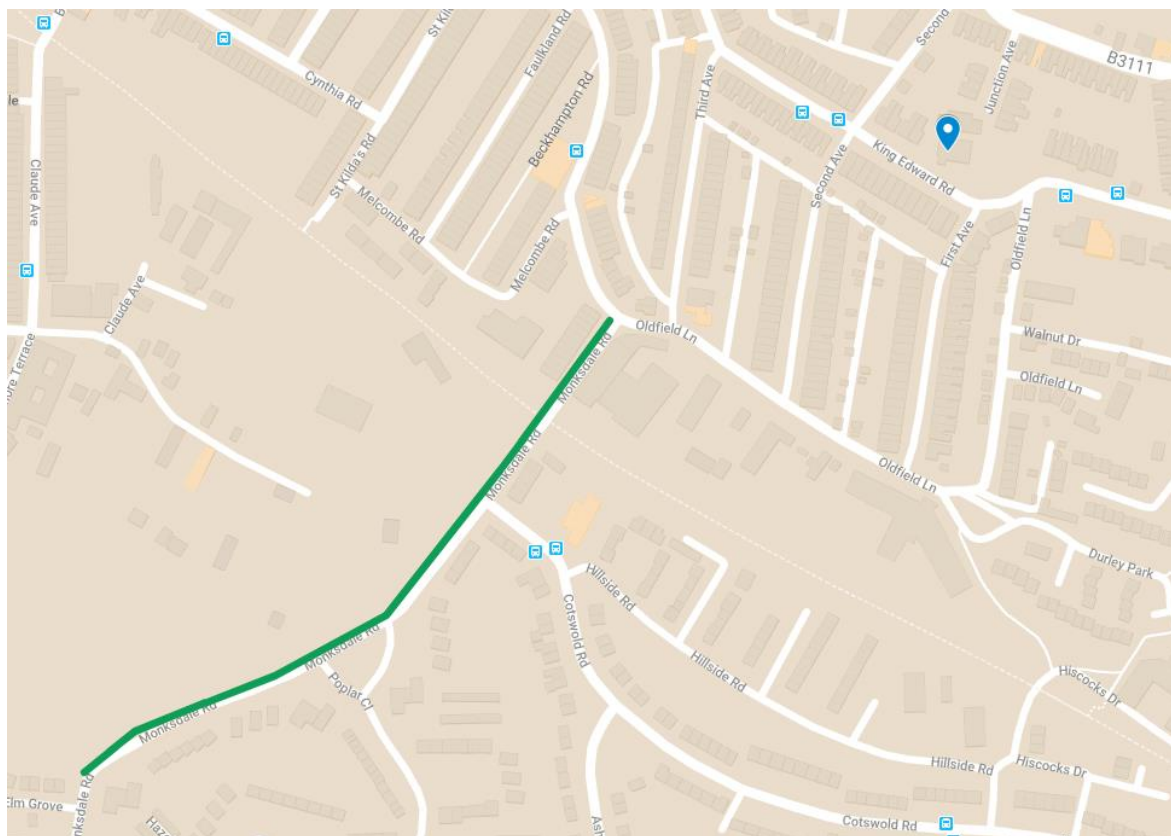
We recommend travelling via train, as St Barts is a short walk from Oldfield Park station (10mins) or slightly longer walk from Bath Spa station (20mins).

Parking

St Bart's Church is now in the middle of a Residents Parking Zone (Zone 28). The parking restrictions in this zone cover 8am–6pm for all 7 days of the week. However, there are some 2 or 3 hour time-limit parking bays in the vicinity of the church that can be used by non-residents.

If you will be visiting St Barts for an SWGP event lasting longer than this, there is a digital sign-in system in the church foyer that allows visitors to park for 4 hours in resident permit bays (renewable during the day). Park in one of these bays, then enter your licence number and parking option on the device in the foyer when you enter the church.

Alternatively, unrestricted parking is available along Monksdale Road, which is a short walk away:
